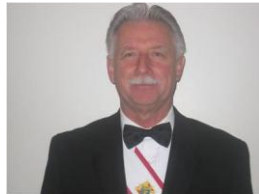

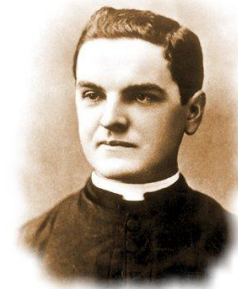

It's what I'm required to do.



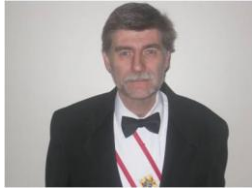

Comptroller's Report

For all members who have not paid their dues, you must get them to me this month or you will be assessed an additional \$5.00 on the amount you pay for dues. I would be rather be doing other work for the assembly then chasing down our Sir Knights for their membership dues. It takes time and money sending out notices and that is the reason why the members passed the motion in September for the late fee.

We are looking at ways to cut costs or we will be slipping well into the red if we do not. The biggest cost we have encountered thus far is paying for meals for Sir Knights who do not show up for them. At the rate we are going, this may be close to \$1,000 by the end of the fraternal year. This is not good because it will take the dues of 40% of our members to make this up. The dues is our main source of revenue so it really hurts us to pay for these extra meals. We need to have members commit only to meals that they can go to. Other expenses are mailing bulletins, keeping our equipment up to par, going to functions and other general assembly expenses. We have reserve money so we will be ok, for now, but running deficits never looks good.

Our Assembly currently has 153 members. We are one of the larger Assemblies in our district. There are six councils that have a combined total of over 900 members so we have a lot of potential 4th degree members out there. Let's keep active and keep growing. We have a great Assembly and there is nothing wrong with making it even greater. God bless and keep well.

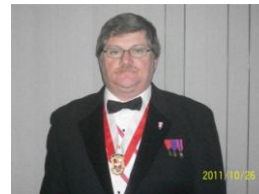
Some members have approached me regarding bulk purchase of white gloves with the snap cuff closure. I am currently looking into this to secure the best price, and will advise everyone in the near future.

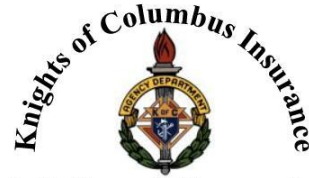
