The next exemplification committee meeting is Sunday May 15TH 7:00 pm at the K C hall in Kingsville. This meeting includes volunteers at the exemplification.

Most of our work planning the exemplification is done, with some work left in these remaining few weeks. I ask everyone to please keep the many volunteers and especially the candidates in your prayers this month and on the day of the exemplification. Everybody's help is needed including your prayers to have the Holy Spirit continue guide us to make this day special and memorable for everyone.

At our April general meeting, F. Captain SK Dan Orawski presented a clear picture of the new prices at all our Councils and K of C halls. The changes to the tax system were the main reason for the increase of prices. After much discussion it was decided by the membership to increase the price charged for the general meeting dinner to \$12 per person with the Christmas and BBQ dinners remaining at \$15 per person. This change will take effect beginning in September 2011. Please keep in mind that we're currently incurring a loss every month because the membership authorized a \$10 per person price for this fraternal year and we promised to review this with the membership at the end of the fraternal year.

With May upon us, this brings green grass, flowers and trees coming back to life, and dare I say more rain, the annual State Convention and of course the annual election of officers for the next fraternal year. For those executive officers who will be leaving at the end of this year, I extent my thanks to each of you for your service.
